NCIC Championships – Stuart Schultz

2020 has hit us with a bang and the National Cricket Inclusion Championships in Geelong were upon us again. A fantastic cross section of state representation (3 North West, 5 North and 5 South) and 4 new players into the team headed off from their respective ports on Sunday 12th January.

With high hopes on Monday, the team were fantastic in their first fixtured game against NSW defeating them by 9 wickets. NSW 9/90 (Connor Sheppard 4/9, Scott Crowden 1/8, Zeb Hovington 1/10, Craig Blaschke 1/13, Alex Cort 1/14) lost to Tasmania 1/91 (Zeb Hovington 36, Connor Sheppard 33no). The second game on Monday against Queensland was a much closer affair. Bowling first, we did a magnificent job restricting Queensland to 7/102 but in response could only muster up 8/84 going down by 18 runs. Queensland 7/102 (Justin Nilon 3/15, Blake Bonnitcha 2/16, Craig Blaschke 1/17) defeated Tasmania 8/84 (Joel Corbett 28, Justin Nilon 19).



Unfortunately, Tuesday and Wednesday didn't go to plan as heavy smoke covered Geelong forcing all games across both days to be cancelled. The silver lining was our 3rd position on the ladder giving us the chance to play against Victoria for a spot in the grand final! Victoria batted first and posted only 5/139 – our team were fantastic restricting the best state in the competition to a score well below what they were expecting. We did our best in response but went down in the end by 74 runs. Victoria 5/139 (MJ Parbs 1/8, Zeb Hovington 1/11, Blake Bonnitcha 1/17, Tyson Parbs 1/18, Craig Blaschke 1/22) defeated Tasmania 6/65 (Blake Bonnitcha 16no, Joel Corbett 16, Justin Nilon 14no).



On the Friday, we played a friendly match against WA - a great bunch of players. In a match with no bearings on results, our team had a great win with contributions across the board. Overall, our team was well behaved, well respected and a shining light in regards to improvement. Our 3rd placing is a reflection on improvements being made across the state and the leadership of the team. Thanks again to Liam Devlin who gives up his time to coach the team every year— we simply could not achieve what we do without him. 'Devo's' dedication to this cricket team and the individuals who make it up is humbling.

We also thank Josh Marshall from Cricket Tasmania who assisted the team throughout the week, and Nicole Parbs and Lenny Marshall who were on hand all week assisting team management.

The 2020 national Inclusion Cricket Carnival returned to Geelong for a big week of cricket!

Day one was a big day with our first match against New South Wales. We managed to put in a really good bowling performance and restricted NSW to 91 with Connor Shepherd taking 4/9 off his 4 overs. Our run chase started positively with Connor Shepherd and Zeb Hovington putting on 81 for the first wicket before Zeb was out for 36. Then young Joel Corbett came out to finish the job with Connor.

Our second game against Queensland saw a top bowling effort to restrict Queensland to 102, with Craig Blaschke taking 1/17 off 4 overs, Blake Bonnitcha taking 2/16 off 3, and Justin Nilon taking 3/15 off 4. Our batting didn't go so well in this game but there was a lot of positive signs we made 8/84 off 20. Once again young Joel put in a great performance with the bat making 28 and also Justin Nilon made 19.

Days 2 and 3 were called off due to smoke – it was a pretty frustrating time for the guys, but at the end of the day player safety is the priority for Cricket Australia. Day 4 was semi-final day - our first time in the semi-finals at the championships. We played Victoria who made 5/139 with MJ and Tyson Parbs both taking crucial wickets. We made 6/65 off 20 with bat. Once again it was amazing, quality cricket - well done to all players involved.

This year we had a lot of youth in the side which is a good sign for inclusion cricket. Also this year the guys really wanted to do something for the bushfire relief. Coach Liam organised some printed stickers and the team sold them throughout the carnival and raising \$1200 for the bushfires - congratulations to everybody involved!

On behalf of the entire team I would like to say thank you to Coach Liam Devlin, our team manager Stuart Schultz and our support staff Josh Marshall, Lenny Marshall and Nicole Parbs for all the work and time they gave to the Team. It doesn't go unrecognised as we all really appreciate it. It can be a tough gig at times, so thank you from the bottom of our hearts to our wonderful supporters here in Tasmania and afar. We thank you for all your support throughout this carnival, we really appreciate all the messages we received. Finally, it's been a pleasure to Captain such a wonderful team and can't wait see this team grow in the years to come.

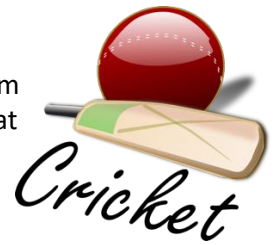
Christmas Parade
